New Mexico Filmmakers Intensive offers an immersion in three key creative above-the-line tracks:

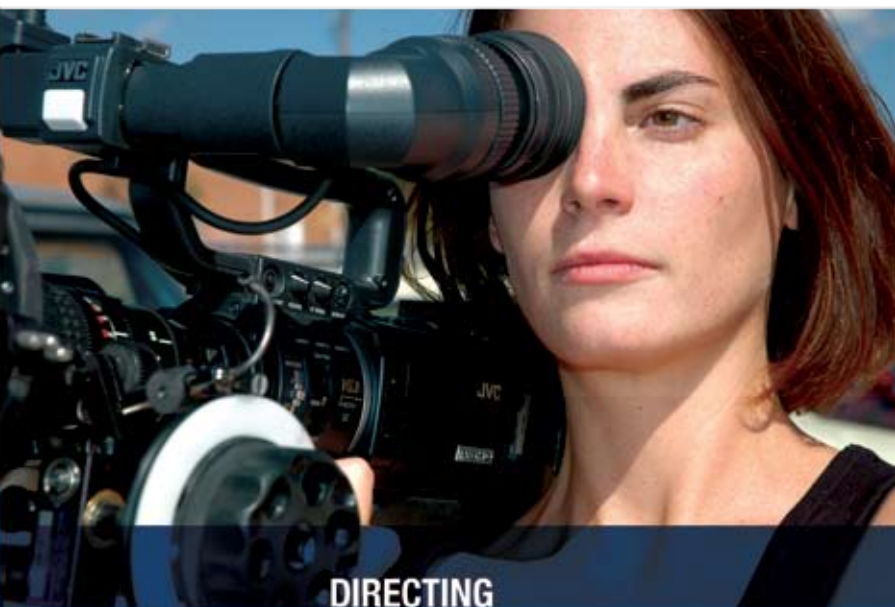


SCREENWRITING

Intimate, in-depth workshops by leading Hollywood filmmakers provide insider knowledge, seasoned perspectives and stories from the trenches in this special ongoing series.



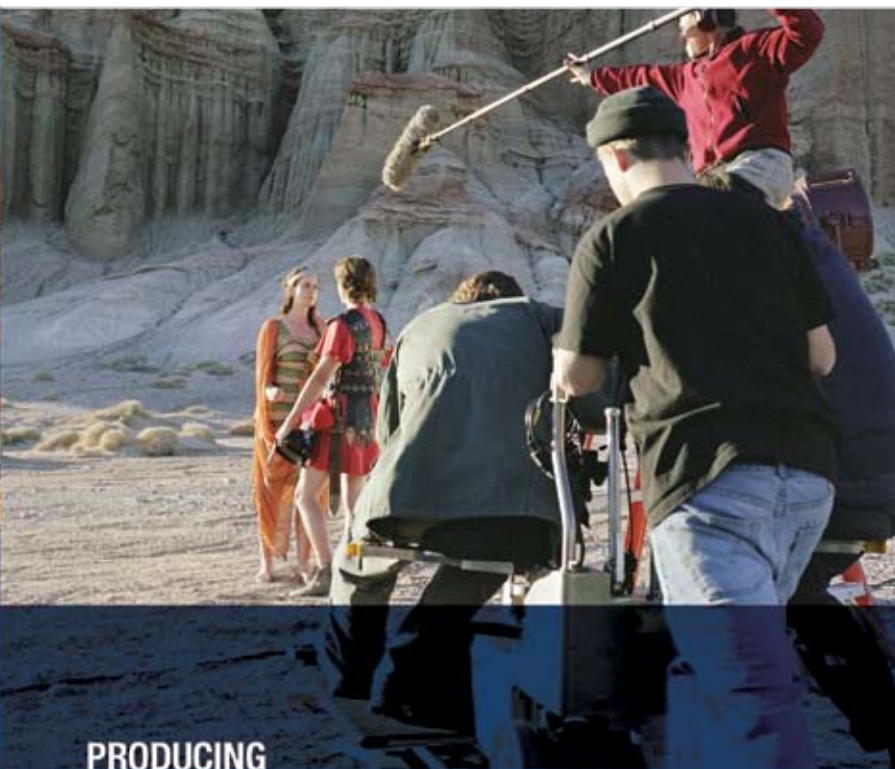
DIRECTING
